# Project Summary



Project Title - Kwara South Medical Intervention

Number of Towns - 10 towns (Shaare, Omu Aran, Osi, Offa, Erinle, Igbaja, Ilofa, Owu-Isin, Gonmo, and Ajase-Ipo towns)

General Medical Checkup Beneficiaries - 3,968 individuals

Eye Screening Beneficiaries - 1,959 individuals

Number of Eye Drops Distributed - 1,385 eye drops

Number of Eye Glasses Distributed - 902 eyeglasses

Number of Cataract Cases Identified - 809 cataract cases

Number of Cataract Surgeries - 103 cataract surgeries

Total Beneficiaries - 5,927 beneficiaries were recorded in total



# Project Description

The ‘Kwara South Medical Intervention Program’ is being organized by Sakinah Medical Outreach (SMO), to increase the accessibility of the residents of the selected townships to quality healthcare services, and also to help raise awareness around the importance of proper hygiene, and use of professional healthcare institutions while seeking for medical services. This, aligns with SMO’s mission, as an organization that hopes to bridge the gap between quality health services and poor Nigerians.

This year, the Kwara South Medical Intervention is sponsored by Prof. Wale Sulaiman (CON), a senatorial candidate aspirant for Kwara South senatorial district. The project was carried out between November 2022, and February 2023, at the Shaare, Omu Aran, Osi, Offa, Erinle, Igbaja, Ilofa, Owu-Isin, Gonmo, and Ajase-Ipo town of Kwara state. .

## Project Objectives

The objectives here are as follows;

- To carry out general medical checkups for 5,000 residents of Kwara south.
- To carry out eye screening exercises for 3,000 community members.
- To carry out 100 cataract surgeries.
- To gift out 1,000 eyeglasses and 700 eye drops to individuals in need.



# Project Activities

The following are the major activities carried out during the medical outreach;

- Registration of volunteers and participants.
- Record of vitals like blood pressure by volunteer nurses.
- Carrying out malaria and blood tests by the lab scientist.
- Carrying out general medical checkups by medical doctors.
- Eye screening exercise carried out by the ophthalmologist.
- Distribution of eyeglasses and eye drops was carried out.
- Distribution of medications for other health complaints
- Cataract surgeries after screening exercise.

# Performance Indicators

The following are the stated performance indicator;

- Number of people screened
- Number of eyeglasses gifted out
- Number of eye drops and medication distributed
- Number of cataract cases detected
- Number of drugs given out for medical complains
- Number of Cataract Surgeries.



# Project Achievements

The following were the outcomes of the program;

- 10 towns** benefited from the outreach; Shaare, Omu Aran, Osi, Offa, Erinle, Igbaja, Ilofa, Owu-Isin, Gonmo, and Ajase-Ipo towns of Kwara state.
- 3,968 individuals** benefited from the general medical checkup
- 1,959 individuals** benefited from the eye screening
- 1,385 eye drops** were distributed
- 902 eyeglasses** were gifted out
- 809 cataract cases** were identified
- 103 cataract surgeries** were carried out
- 5,927 beneficiaries** were recorded in total

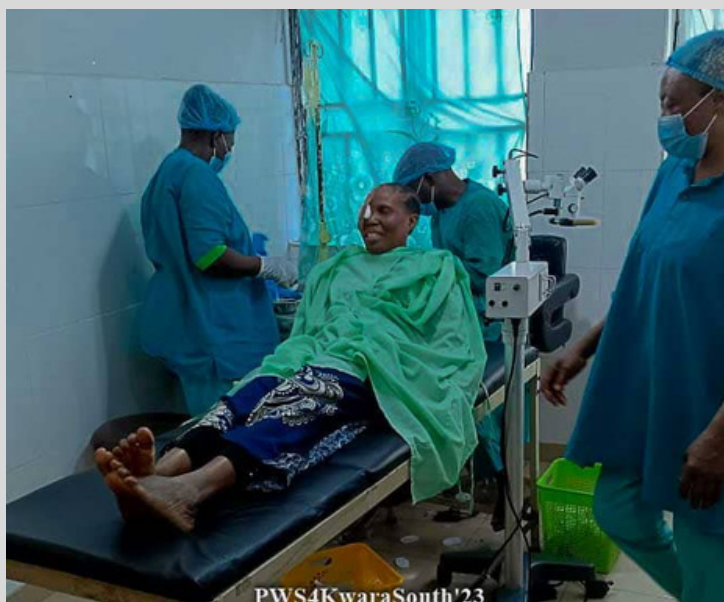


# Conclusion
